They are located at at the foyer & Mitchell St. entrance.

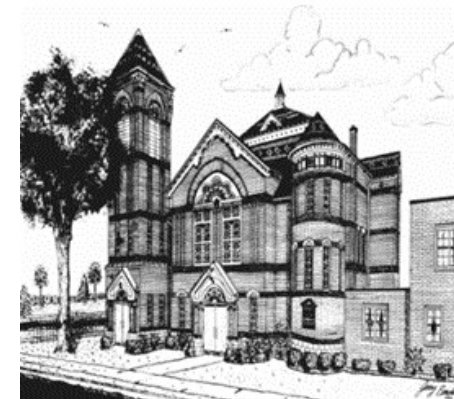
The Nursery?
